These collaborations reflect a shared vision of empowering students and fostering educational access. By providing scholarships and comprehensive support services, BBBSEMO aims to equip students with the resources they need to thrive academically and achieve their goals.

"We were thrilled to commemorate this significant partnership," remarked Eboni Buckels. "As we celebrated this milestone, we were enthusiastic about advancing our mission of empowering young alumni and equipping them with the necessary resources for success. Our collaborations with the University of Missouri - St. Louis (UMSL) and Missouri State University (MSU) presented exciting opportunities to make a positive impact on the lives of our future leaders."
